RULES

- Only entries from swimmers that have registered with SSA through their provinces will be accepted. KZN Swimmers must be registered by 19th September 2016.
- Swimmers from outside of KZN must submit their clearances and supply their official times as per the SSA database via commlink file. (Entries should be done through their Provinces) Please submit hard copies of individual entries as well relays for checking purposes.
- Do not forget to enter your relays. Please submit a hardcopy of your relays with your entries.
- For seeding purposes only official times as per the SSA database will be accepted
- The age of the swimmers shall be determined as of the 6th October 2016
- The one start rule will apply and the gala will be run as per FINA, SSA & KZNA rules
- All events are Timed Finals
- Swimmers MUST report to the Clerk of the Course prior to their event(s).
- Objections must be submitted in writing to the Meet Referee. The Meet Referee's decision will be final.

SRATCHINGS:

It is not necessary to scratch, however, scratching will be accepted to accommodate Late Entries There will not be a Managers Meeting. Coaches/Managers packs will be available at the ETD Desk

Entry Fees:

R40 registration fee per swimmer

R15 per individual event

R30 per Relay

Late entry Fee: R50 per individual event; R100 per Relay

Late entries will only be accepted if the swimmer is already entered into the Meet and lane are available.

SCORINGS/AWARDS:

- This gala will be contested on an inter-Club basis
- A floating Trophy will be awarded to the Club scoring the most points
- The fastest Top 8 swimmers will score per event. Points will be awarded as follows:
10,9,8,7,6,5,4,3,2,1
- Swimmers breaking a record will be awarded a Bonus of 10 points.
- Relays will be awarded Double points; records in the relays will be awarded 10 Bonus points.
- Medals will be awarded to the First, Second & Third fastest Swimmer in each event.
- Trophies / Cash prizes will be awarded to the Top Juvenile 14/U Boy & Girl; Cash prize to the Second and Third Boy & Girl
- Trophies / Cash prizes will be awarded to the Top Open 15/0 Male & Female; Cash prize to the Second and Third Male & Female
- To qualify for the above, swimmers will only score points in their own Age-Group.
- Swimmers may enter all events in their own age-group as well as the Open events on condition that they do not enter the same event in their own Age Group. (Junior swimmers 14/U will NOT score points in the Open events; only swimmers 15/O can score points in the Open events).

Relays:

- Clubs may enter 2 relay Teams per event. Only the nominated 'A' Team will score points. B-Teams will awarded medals if the finish in the top 3 placings. Swimmers of a younger age group may participate.
- COMBINED TEAMS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO TAKE PART IN THE RELAY EVENTS, except on an unofficial basis.
- Relay swimmers must be entered into the Meet as individual swimmers
- Names of the swimmers for the Relays must be submitted before the end of the morning session on the day the relays are swum.

DISTANCE EVENTS:

- Only the top 20 entry times will be accepted for the 400IM and Women's 800 Freestyle
- Only the top 10 entry times will accepted for the Men's 1500m Freestyle.
- In the event that there are NT entries, a draw will take place to fill the lanes if space available
- Swimmers will be required to confirm participation in the distance events by 08h00 on the day of the event.
- No extra heats will be set up and no refunds on entries will be given.

GENERAL:

Club are to please supply Officials/Timekeepers as per the following:

The names of the Officials/timekeepers must be submitted with entries

- 1 – 3 Swimmers entered – NO OFFICIALS
- 4 – 10 Swimmers entered – min 2 Officials (Timekeepers or Judges)
- 11 – 20 Swimmers entered – min 3 Officials (Timekeepers or Judges)
- 21 - 30 Swimmers entered – min 4 Officials (Timekeepers or Judges)
- 31 - 40 Swimmers entered – min 4 Officials (Timekeepers or Judges)
- 41 + Swimmers entered – min 5 Officials (Timekeepers or Judges)

All officials and timekeepers are to report for duty in the Waterpolo room.
